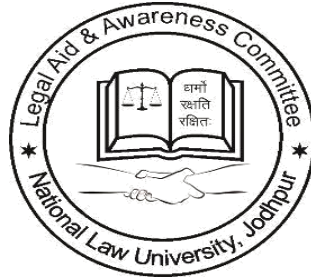

An Initiative to maximize the number of admission under Section 12.1.c of the Right to Education Act 2009 for Weaker and Disadvantaged Section

(A Competition Organized by Legal Aid and Awareness Committee, National Law University, Jodhpur)

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A. About the Committee

The Legal Aid and Awareness Committee (LAAC) is a student run body of National Law University Jodhpur which works towards imparting practical knowledge and information regarding the basic legal rights and remedies to the masses. LAAC has undertaken initiatives aimed at spreading legal awareness and improving the quality of life of socially and economically less privileged class by helping them attain their rights under the social beneficial legislations.

In pursuance of the same, we are organizing the 3rd Edition of “Mil Kar Karein RTE ko Sarthak” Competition, in the higher educational institutions of Jodhpur City. The objective of this competition is to realize the true spirit of the Right to Education Act, 2009.

B. Background and Experience

The LAAC in the past has conducted an empirical research on implementation of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 in the government schools of Rajasthan. The findings of the study have been submitted to the Honorable High Court of Rajasthan in the form of Public Interest Litigation. Currently, matter is been pending before the Honorable High Court of Rajasthan. The same could be viewed on our website <www.nlujlaac.in> .

The first edition of the competition received a good response and involved a participation of more than 250 students from various colleges of Jodhpur. The Competition marked a success by securing **108 admissions** of children in different private schools of Jodhpur under the scheme. After the success of the first edition, we organized the second edition of our competition where we successfully secured **158 admissions**. A total cash prize of Rs. 25,000 was awarded to the winners along with a participation certificate to all the students. The active participation of students motivates us to further organize the third edition of the competition.

Besides this project, the committee has been consistently working towards the transformation of the nearby village ‘Surpura’ into a smart village. The committee has organized several workshops related to Right to Information (RTI) and Right to Education (RTE). The committee in the past has also been writing in the local newspapers on the several legal issues. Moreover, the legal aid clinic, a part of the committee provides need based legal aid and extends to provide legal representation to the needy.

C. About the Competition

Section 12(1)(c) of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (hereinafter RTE Act) mandates private schools to reserve 25% seats for the weaker and disadvantaged section of the society. However, children working in hotels, factories and our own homes put a big question mark on the implementation of the act.

Therefore, LAAC is organizing this Competition among 25 Colleges of Jodhpur. We are organizing this competition with an aim to-

- 1) Sensitize youth about the problem of illiteracy in the Country.
- 2) Create Legal Awareness among masses about the social beneficial legislation.
- 3) Help/Support government in the implementation of the 25% reservation for weaker and disadvantaged section rule in private schools.

D. Definitions

Annexure: Documents required for verification of the statements in the admission form.

Admission form- Form provided by Rajasthan Government for admission under Section 12(1)(c) of the Right to Education Act, 2009.

Committee: The Legal Aid and Awareness Committee (LAAC) of National Law University, Jodhpur.

Clarification: Explanation to any enquiry provided by the Organizer.

Competition: Mil Kar Karein RTE ko Sarthak.

Disadvantaged Section: Members belonging to the Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled tribes (ST), applicant or his parents/guardians suffering from HIV/ Cancer, children of War Widows, applicant falling under the definition of PWD Act, 1995, applicant belonging to Backward Class/ Special Backward Class whose parents earn 1 lakh or less annually, applicants whose parents belong to Below Poverty Line (BPL) as per the Central or State List.

Interim Review: Review conducted by the Committee to check the correctness of the required documents and details filled in the admission form.

Organizer: Legal Aid and Awareness Committee, National Law University, Jodhpur.

Orientation Session: Training session organized by the Committee to inform the teams about the process and stages of the competition and the admission process.

Right to Education (RTE): Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 which provides to every child of the age of six to fourteen years the right to free and compulsory education.

Submission: Submission means depositing of hard copies of admission forms and photocopy of documents.

University: National Law University, Jodhpur.

Weaker Section: Applicants whose parents/guardians earn 1 Lakh or less than 1 Lakh rupees per annum.

E. Consent and Participation

a. Eligibility for Participation

Students of the University and other identified colleges in the city of Jodhpur will be eligible to participate in the Competition. The students shall have to participate in the Competition in teams comprising of **minimum 2 members** and **maximum 5 members**.

b. Registration process

Registration of the teams is mandatory to participate in the Competition. Each team will have to pay Rs 250/- as registration fees. The payment can be made to:-

- 1) Faculty Coordinator in cash along with the hard copy of registered form, or
- 2) Through **PayTm to +91-8874703922** and mail the filled registered form along with the screenshot of paytm payment to <laacforrte2018@gmail.com>.

c. Withdrawal and Non-Participation

Eligible participants are encouraged not to withdraw from the Competition once registered. This is in order to further the objective of the Competition and enhance the practical knowledge of the participants about Right to Education.

In the case of withdrawal and non-participation, the registration fee which has been submitted **shall not be refunded** by the Committee.

F. Stages of the Competition

- 1) Team Formation and Registration
- 2) Orientation Session (Training how to fill forms and collect documents)
- 3) Field Work (Filling Admission forms and Collecting document of weaker and disadvantaged children)
- 4) Interim Review by the Organiser
- 5) Online Submission of the forms on Rajasthan Private School Portal
- 6) Final Submission of the documents in the school

G. Orientation Session

An orientation shall be conducted by the Committee in order to train the teams about the process and stages of filing of admission forms. It is mandatory for all the registered teams to attend the Orientation Session organized by the Committee.

H. Submission of Admission forms and documents for Interim Review

The Teams will have to submit required documents in **Hard Copy** for interim review on the prescribed date. The following documents have to be submitted:-

1) **Cover Letter:**

It will include college name, name of the team leader, number of admission forms and annexures.

2) **Admission Forms:**

The admission form will consist of four sections:

- Details of Applicant
- Information of the parents/guardian of the applicant
- Complete address of the parents/guardian
- Class of the Applicant (Weaker or disadvantaged)

All the teams will be provided with a format of the admission form and they will be required to use the photocopy of the form in order to fill it for various children.

The teams have to ensure that they will not fill the form of the child which has already been covered by another team. If overlapping is found, first form to be received by the Committee will be accepted as a valid entry.

3) Annexures:

Participants will attach following annexures with each admission form:-

Documents required for Weaker Section:-

- 1) Income Certificate that parents/guardians earn less than 1 Lakh rupees per annum.
- 2) Resident proof of child/parents.
- 3) Birth Certificate of the Child/ any other document related to the proof of age of the child.
- 4) Aadhaar card of the parents and child

Documents required for Disadvantaged Section:-

- 1) Aadhaar card of the parents and child
- 2) Resident proof of child/parents.
- 3) Birth Certificate of the Child/ any other document related to the proof of age of the child
- 4) SC Certificate of parents/child Or
ST Certificate of parents/child
Or
Declaration of the orphan status of the child from orphanage Or
A report from a Registered Diagnostic Center that the child is suffering from HIV/Cancer
Or

Certificate of proof that mother is a war widow

Or

PWD Certificate

Or

Income certificate of Backward Class/ Special Backward Class parents that their annual income is less than 1 Lakh rupees

Or

BPL Card (Based on Center List or State List)

I. Online Submission of Admission Form

Teams will have to fill online admission forms on Rajasthan Private School Portal. rte.raj.nic.in/Home/StudentApplyOnline.aspx.

Teams will have to email the Application number and registered mobile number of the parents/guardian used in filing the online form to the Committee at laacforrte2018@gmail.com.

J. Submission of Documents in the Schools

Rajasthan Government uses computerized lottery system for deciding the priority list for the admission of the applicants. After lottery is published, teams will have to accompany parents/guardian to the schools and help them in submission of documents.

K. Basis of Adjudication

Winner team will be decided by the Organiser (LAAC). Criteria for the winner will be the following –

1) Maximum number of accurate admission form

Each accurate admission form will carry 40 marks.

2) Accuracy of the documents for the verification

All the required documents will carry weightage of 60 marks.

3) Maximum number of final admissions

There will be bonus of 5 marks for each successful admission.

L. Penalties and Disqualification

S . No	HEADING	PENALTIES
1.	Any discrepancy or missing detail in one section of the admission form	5 marks per section
2.	Any discrepancy between the admission form and the required document.	5 marks
3.	Non-submission of the required document	15 marks per document
4.	Delay in Submission for interim review ¹	5 marks till next day noon, 10 marks per day for any further delay

Disqualification

Following grounds will lead to the disqualification of the teams.

- a) Non-submission of the admission forms and annexures for interim review
- b) Not filling online admission form on the Rajasthan Private School Portal. (Teams will have to mandatorily provide the application number and registered mobile number used in filing the online form to the Committee at nlujaac@gmail.com.)
- c) Any kind of indecent behavior affecting the reputation of the University and the Committee.

M. Exercise of Discretion

The Organizers shall serve as final arbiter of implementation and interpretation of these Rules. The Organizers may take such other measures as are required for the orderly and fair organization of the Competition. The interpretation of the Organizers as to the rules and their implementation shall be final and conclusive.

¹ No documents shall be accepted after 2 days of the specified submission

N. Incentives For Winners

The top 3 teams fulfilling the criteria shall be given cash prizes and a certificate of merit. Furthermore, all the participants of the Competition shall be given a participation certificate.

The amount of cash prizes to be give are as follows-

1st Prize Winner- Rs. 10,000 + Certificate of Merit

2nd Prize Winner- Rs. 8,000 + Certificate of Merit

3rd Prize Winner- Rs. 7,000 + Certificate of Merit
