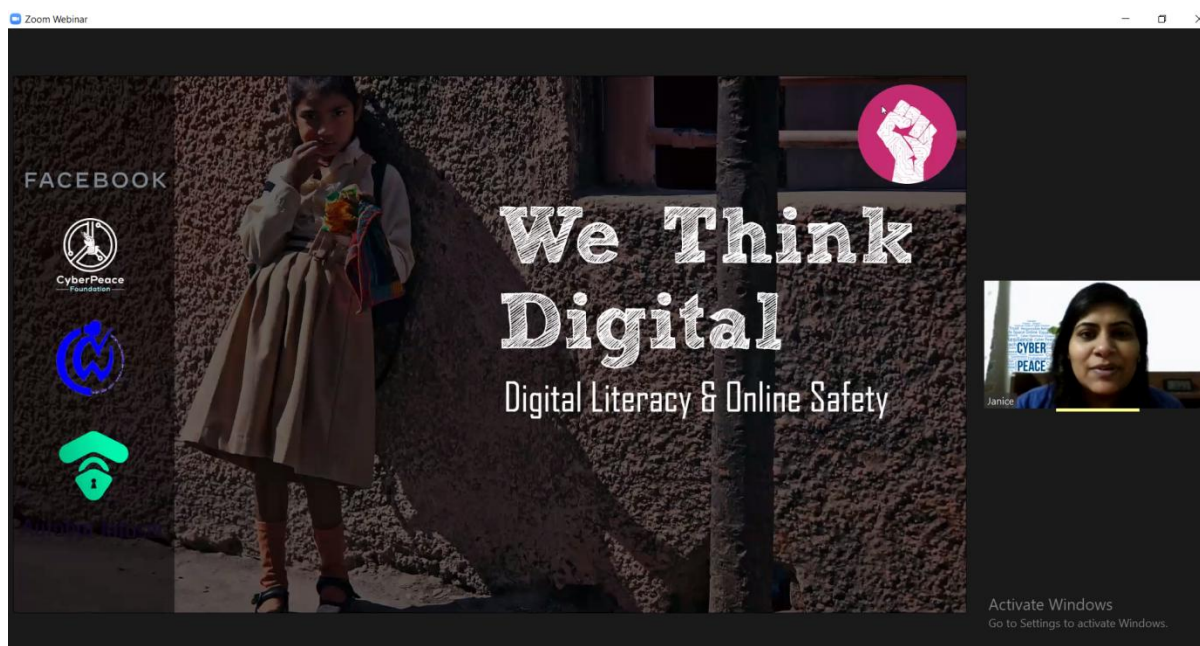


ONLINE TRAINING SESSION: DRISHTI SHAKTI ON CYBER SECURITY

It was a collaborative programme run by the National Commission for Women, Facebook and Cyber Peace Foundation to promote digital literacy among students and train them about the precautions that can be taken online.
