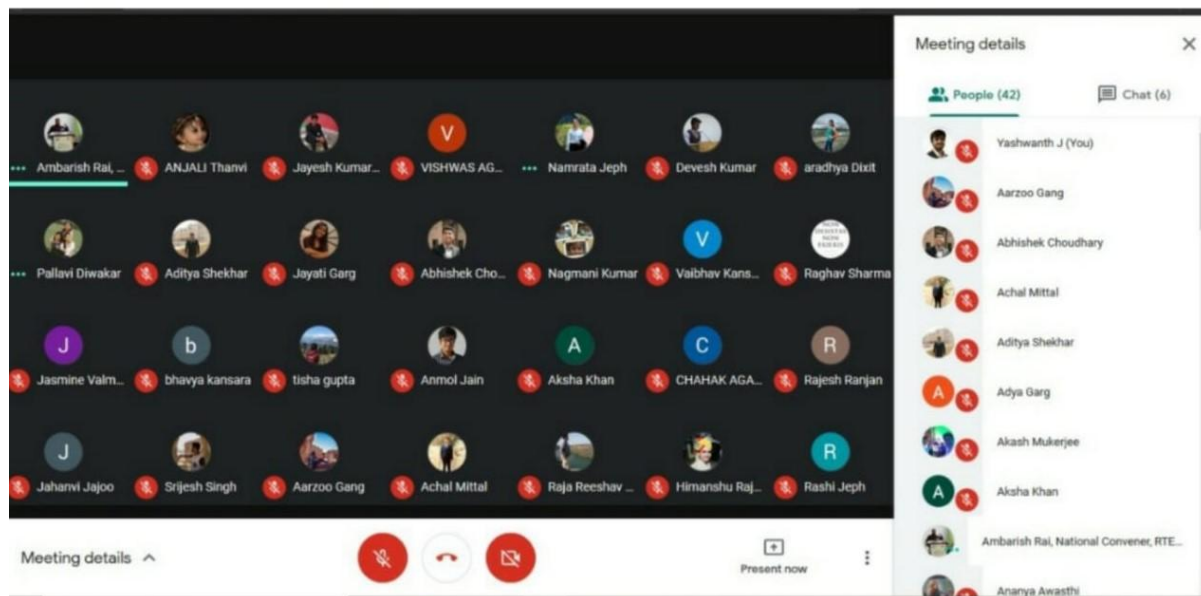


WEBINAR ON LEGISLATIVE SHORTCOMINGS IN INDIA'S PRIMARY
